## 7. Please comment on the overall quality of the instruction in this course.

Comment
The material in this course is very challenging, but the professor managed to present in a fashion that made it unusually intuitive and within reach. This conscientious pedagogical approach created a happy and comfortable atmosphere that really made smoother the experience of distilling many abstract concepts into human-sized pieces.
I enjoyed the material but felt that the instructor did not teach in a way that helped me learn, I found myself just reading the textbook.
This was the most interesting and inspiring course that I have taken at U of T so far. Prof. Bar-Natan always had a clear idea of where and how he was leading the students, always had an interesting and challenging lecture and always followed it by very good assignments; the textbook greatly tied to the course as well.
Dror Bar-Natan is the best professor I've had so far!!!
It was hard to follow. Often I felt the class was disorganized and many key concepts weren't clearly defined. He would use too many analogies and define things in imprecise ways that really did nothing for me at all. When asking questions the professor's responses were often intentionally vague (for instance, asking whether we should review something or not for a quiz). I'd say more than 80% of my learning came from the textbook and very little from lectures and class notes. When asking for help is sometimes unapproachable and not very helpful and sometimes you feel like he doesn't want you around. However, I do appreciate the fact that he is very nice, is often very funny and oftentimes DOES explain things precisely and clearly and in great depth, and I do understand that a lot of the course material is too advanced to go into great and absolute depth since we do have limited time.
Instruction is sometimes quite disorganized and difficult to follow.
Professor Bar-Natan was very skilled at creating a learning environment suited for the difficult topics in this course, and at explaining the concepts clearly and intuitively.
Prof Bar-Natan has been the best lecturer I have ever had. His pace is on point, and he explains the intuition of the material first, which makes the hard stuff very accessible.
Superb, excellent, enthusiastic instruction; great assignments.
Professor Bar-Natan is very knowledgeable. And MAT257 is one of the few math courses I have taken so far that actually get to complete the syllabus without rushing through and skipping. The tests are fair, I think the averages of the class were reasonable. Tests did not take place during regular lecture hours, which gave us sufficient time to do the tests in addition to earning us more time for lectures. This was essentially for the completion of the syllabus. I am very satisfied.

Professor Bar Natan was great. His lectures were good and he was excellent at motivating concepts. The material was challenging, but it was delivered in a way so that the challenge didn't come from poor presentation or organization of the course, unfair or unfairly specific exam questions, or ridiculous tests, but from the math itself. This made the course appealing and fun to work at, and extremely rewarding. The problem sets were challenging but fair and so were the exams. Overall, it was a fantastically planned and excellently delivered course.
Dror's insights into certain topics as well as his intuitive explanation coupled with the textbook made traditionally very difficult to grasp topics extremely digestible!

The motivation and clarity provided by the instructor is unrivalled in all courses I have ever taken. Entertaining and helpful lectures combined with a good textbook and well-designed tests and problem sets made this course an excellent experience.
Very clear and intuitive.
The course was consistently taught very well. With a few minor exceptions, concepts were taught with a strong emphasis on understanding that respected the student's intelligence without moving too quickly. At the same time,

rigour was not neglected except in certain tedious cases, where supplementary reading from the textbook was necessary (and sufficient). Seemingly unapproachable material was carefully built up, and at the end of the course I found myself greatly improved in mathematical maturity as well as in the specifics of the content taught.

The professor clearly had an infectious enthusiasm for mathematics generally (reflected in riddles and other extra content), and was committed to helping to induct the students into the mathematical community, with his forthright commentary on the topics studied ("this is boring but useful," and so on).

He tried really hard to help students understanding the material and I really appreciated it.

The professor taught very well. Other than a few weak parts near the end of general integration, the course was taught really well.

I really really liked this course and Dror was fantastic at making the material exciting and accessible in lecture. Great at answering questions too, and fun riddles.

Dror is an excellent teacher. His lectures are always well organized and his homework assignments and tests are extraordinarily clear in the way they are written. He lays out his expectations well and equips us well to meet them - through providing lecture handouts, encouraging classmates to share notes, etc

Dror did an amazing job fully rigorously explaining concepts with insightful examples and terminology that eased into formality throughout the year.

**Comment**

The professor's office hours and the TAs for this course were great—deeply informative.

Both Teaching Assistants and Prof. Bar-Natan held numerous office hours and were always reachable.

My TA Jihad often overcomplicated things and went off topic to principles that weren't related to the course and I often felt intimidated. The last few weeks I decided not to go to his tutorials anymore because I wasn't getting anything out of them and they caused me needless hassle.

Professor Bar-Natan provided several resources for assistance in the course, including an online portal where students could share notes, homework solutions, and other resources. As for the tutorials, I could hardly attend any because of a conflict I had with another course.

The TA's really impressed me with their willingness to go out of their way to help.

TA's were very helpful and approachable. Nothing to complain.

The TAs were pretty helpful, most of the time.

The tutorials were somewhat lacking but the textbook made up for it.

The professor and one of the TAs have office hours every week, as well as extended office hours before the tests.

The online website is really helpful for review and community.

I found the tutorials to be completely unhelpful. The wiki which was set up by the instructor was an excellent resource which complemented the course's style. This undoubtedly took a large amount of time for the professor to set up and maintain, and it was greatly appreciated by the students.

The assistance is very accessible.

Office hours by both the professor and the teaching assistants were accessible and helpful. Tutorials themselves pre-empted many of the questions that would otherwise be asked, and were well worth attending.

Some of the materials in the lecture are lack of details.

Prof. Bar-Natan had office hours the night before the test that helped immensely and I would love to see this more often.







**9. The instructor generated enthusiasm for learning in the course.**




