Sample output using ws-jktr bibliography style file

- (1) article: text [1–3]
- (2) proceedings: text [4]
- (3) inproceedings: text [5, 6]
- (4) book: text [7]
- (5) edition: text [8]
- (6) editor: text [9]
- (7) series: text [10]
- (8) tech report: text [11, 12]
- (9) unpublished: text [13]
- (10) phd thesis: text [14]
- (11) masters thesis: text [15]
- (12) incollection: text [16]
- (13) booklet: text [17]
- (14) misc: When the reference forms part of the sentence, it should not be typed in superscripts, e.g.: “One can show from Ref. 17 that ...”
